The University of Chicago and the Oriental Institute have the honor to host the 10th International Congress of Hittitology, the triennial gathering of Hittitologists and Anatolianists. The meeting will be held in Chicago, USA, on August 28th-September 1st, 2017. Sessions will be held in Breasted Hall, the Oriental Institute, and Saieh Hall, across from the Oriental Institute. Publishers will have the opportunity to exhibit books and brochures.

Accommodations

Our website has been updated with information on accommodations. Please go there to explore the options (<https://ich10.uchicago.edu/page/accommodations>). We have blocked a total of 80 rooms in different venues at reduced conference rates, ranging from relatively inexpensive dorm rooms on campus to hotel rooms in a lively shopping and dining district of Hyde Park. The hotels, within walking distance of the conference, provide shuttle services to campus. For students there is the option to stay with Chicago students for free.

Workshops

ICH 10 invites the submission of workshop proposals. Workshops should emphasize current topics of particular interest, and should include a mix of regular papers, invited presentations and panels that encourage the participation of attendees in active discussion. Papers and posters

Papers (in English, French, German, Italian and Turkish) should cover all aspects of Hittitology and Anatolian studies until the beginning of the AD era. Twenty minutes will be available for the papers, and five minutes for discussion.

Please send the title of the proposed paper or poster with an abstract (of no more than 300 words) to ich10@uchicago.edu by May 31, 2017 at the latest. Put “Proposed paper (or poster) and abstract” and your name in the subject line. Only the papers presented at the congress will be published in the Proceedings.


